

IBA-PU ALUMNI CANADA BY-LAWS

ARTICLE I: NAME

The name of this organization shall be the IBA-PU ALUMNI CANADA referred as "IBAPUAC"

ARTICLE II: PURPOSE

The IBAPUAC is established to support and advance the objectives of the IBA PU Alumni within Canada. The IBAPUAC aims to foster a network among alumni in Canada and promote the welfare and advance the interests of IBA PU Alumni Canada and its members.

ARTICLE III: MEMBERSHIP

- All alumni of IBA PU residing in Canada shall be eligible for membership in the IBA PU Alumni Canada.
- Membership may be terminated by a majority vote of the IBAPUAC Board.
- Non-resident alumni can become member but will not have voting rights

ARTICLE IV: CHAPTER BOARD

- The IBAPUAC Board is responsible for overseeing the operations and activities of the Chapter. The Board shall have up to 10, but not fewer than 3, members.
- Board members shall be elected by the IBAPUAC membership at the annual meeting.
- All Board members shall serve 3-years term and are eligible for re-election for up to 3 consecutive terms.

ARTICLE V: MEETINGS

- The IBAPUAC shall hold regular monthly meetings at least 10 times/year at a place determined by the IBAPUAC Board.
- An annual meeting of the members shall be held at a time and place determined by the IBAPUAC Board.

 Special meetings may be called by the Chair or a majority of the IBAPUAC Board members.

ARTICLE VI: OFFICERS

- The officers of the IBAPUAC shall be a President, Vice-President, Secretary, and Treasurer, elected by the IBAPUAC Board.
- President: Convenes and manages operations of the IBAPUAC
- Vice-President: Assumes duties of the President in their absence.
- Secretary: Responsible for keeping records, taking minutes, and disseminating information to members.
- Treasurer: Manages the financial affairs of the IBAPUAC.

ARTICLE VII: COMMITTEES

The IBAPUAC Board may establish committees as deemed necessary to carry out the objectives and activities of the IBAPUAC.

ARTICLE VIII: AMENDMENTS

These By-Laws may be amended by a two-thirds majority vote of the IBAPUAC Board. Proposed amendments must be submitted in writing to the IBAPUAC membership committee at least 30 days before the voting.
